
Decision and Order

McIntosh, J.

This case came before the Court on the “Motion for Stay” filed on November 22, 2011 by Appellant, ATS Institute of Technology, pursuant to R.C. 119.12, seeking a stay of the Adjudication Order issued by Appellee, the Ohio Board of Nursing, on November 18, 2011. On November 22, 2011, the parties presented oral arguments on the motion. At that time the Court stayed the Adjudication Order until December 31, 2011 and ordered the parties to fully brief the Motion to Stay.

Upon further consideration of the arguments presented at the November 22, 2011 hearing, Appellee’s Memorandum Contra and Appellant’s Reply, the stay of the Adjudication Order is hereby extended until this appeal is fully adjudicated or the end of the Spring semester year, whichever occurs first. Until further order of the Court, Appellant shall not admit any new students to its Associate of Applied Science in Nursing Program until this matter is finally adjudicated.
