JOURNAL ENTRY
DENYING APPELLANT’S MOTION TO STAY
(Motion Filed May 21, 2012)

These consolidated cases involve an appeal of the Ohio State Board of Nursing’s decision to revoke the licensure of Miami-Jacobs Career College’s Practical Nursing Program. In May 2011, the administrative appeal in Case No. 11CVF-01-1089 was remanded to the Board of Nursing to reconvene and fairly and impartially reconsider the case. On May 18, 2012, the Board issued a five-page Adjudication Order which revoked the conditional approval status of Miami-Jacobs, and denied it full approval status.

On May 22, 2012, Miami-Jacobs filed a new administrative appeal of the Board’s May 18, 2012 Order, Case No. 12CVF-05-6565. Miami-Jacobs also filed a Motion to Stay the Board’s Order during the pendency of the appeal, in order for the enrolled students to continue in their program. The new appeal has been

transferred to this branch of the court and consolidated with Miami-Jacobs' 2011 appeal.

On May 23, 2012, a hearing on the Motion to Stay was held on the record. Attorneys Collis and Appel were in attendance. Brenda Cottrell, Program Administrator of the practical nursing program for Miami-Jacobs, and Michael Wise, in-house counsel for the Board of Nursing were also present. For the reasons stated on the record, the Motion to Stay is not well taken, is not in the public interest, and is **DENIED**.
