### **Call to Order**

Sherri Sievers, Chair, recognized a quorum, called the meeting to order at 10:11 a.m. and welcomed members and guests.

### **Review and Approval May 2019 Meeting Minutes**

Barbara Douglas moved to approve the minutes as written; Richard Bakker seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Review New Approved FDA Drugs and Exclusionary Formulary**

After reviewing new drugs approved by the FDA from April 27, 2019, through August 28, 2019, Katherine Clark moved not to add any of the drugs to the Exclusionary Formulary; R. Bakker seconded. The motion passed unanimously. The CPG agreed by general consensus to recommend that the current Exclusionary Formulary be approved by the Board.

### **Board Appointment of CPG member**

One individual applied, and the Board will appoint the new member at the September 18<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting.

### **RN and APRN Renewal**

L. Emrich reported the late processing fee for RN and APRN renewals was effective September 16<sup>th</sup>. Prior eNews and social media communications encouraged nurses to renew early to avoid the late fee. Email notifications now remind nurses to renew before October 31, 2019, to avoid a lapse in license. APRNs that only renewed their RN license will be emailed about renewing their APRN license. 192,993 licenses have been renewed.

L. Emrich said on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, there was a system integration issue that impacted primarily Certified Nurse Specialists by converting their license from active to lapsed and auto-notifying the individuals via email. L. Emrich thanked Jesse McClain, APRN-CNS, for contacting the Board immediately which enabled the Board and eLicense administrators to timely address and correct the issue.

### **Other:**

Tom Dilling stated the Ohio Sunset Review Committee notified the Board it will review the statutory authorization for the CPG, but the Board has not received a review date.
